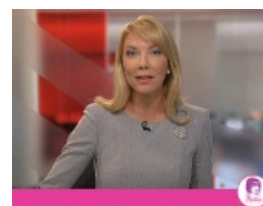


Clare's Law

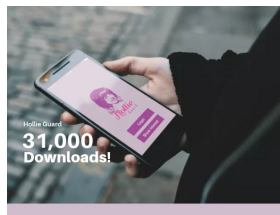
